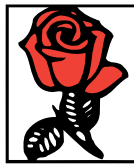

# Accessories – porcelain colours



## Primary kits

Different primary kits / starter kits are available, with different contents, both regarding number of colours and contents of oils or mediums.

## Whirlers – Potter's wheel

Easily running whirlers with cast iron foot - Ø 197 mm, height 155 mm. Available with or without armrest. The armrest can be adjusted in different angles and heights.

## Palette knives

For the mixing of powder colours with oils or mediums. Available in different shapes and sizes.

## Pens

Pen for contour, with reversible pen. Scraping pen for removal of non-fired colours.

## Glass brush

For the burnishing of gold after firing. Available in different widths and lengths.

## Graphite Paper

Size A4. For tracing of motives/ drawings on the porcelain. The black strokes will disappear during the firing.



## Empty colour glasses

In glass or plastic. (not illustrated)

## Glass grinder (Pestle)

For grinding of colour powder on either a tile or a glass plate. Both ends can be used.

## Eraser for gold

100 x 8 x 8 mm. Gold spots can be removed after firing. Some lustre colours can also be removed.

## Wipe-out stick

For removal of wet porcelain colours, the so-called wipe-out technique. Available in different sizes and grades of hardness.

## Foam rubber pounding stick

For applying of porcelain colours on the whole surface (fond). Available in different sizes.

## Pencils

Special pencils which can draw on porcelain. The stroke disappears during the firing. Available in black and white (white for dark surfaces).

## Polishing sponge

For polishing of porcelain colours after firing.

## Covering tape

For covering of white porcelain.
